rabies vaccination.

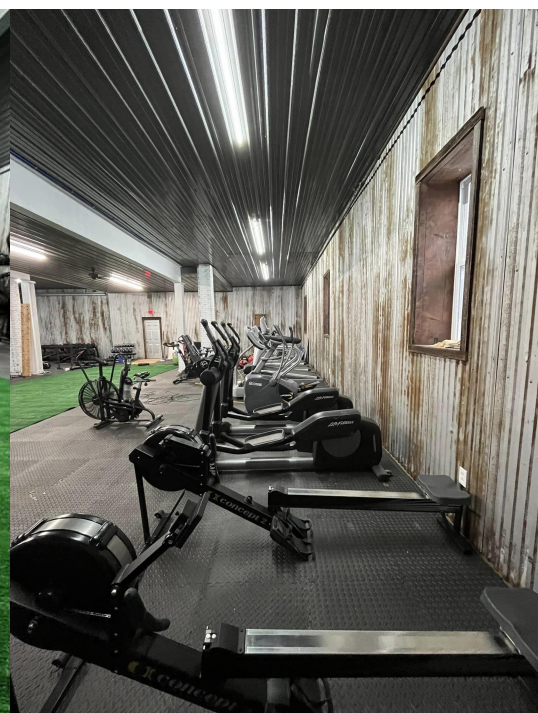
