## WELCOME TO THE LITTLE VALLEY PAVILION

THE LITTLE VALLEY PAVILION CAN BE RENTED OUT FOR A COST OF \$25.00. RESERVATIONS FOR THE PAVILION ARE MADE WITH THE CLERK TREASURER PEGGY ROOT AT THE LITTLE VALLEY MUNICIPAL BUILDING DURING THE HOURS OF 8:00 A.M. TO 4:00 P.M.

- ☺ In order to reserve the pavilion you must provide a contact person, phone number, date, and time of the event, and if you require electric.
- ☺ Trash cans and bags are provided, but **all garbage must be taken with you when you leave.**
- ☺ Notification must be given to the Clerk Treasurer, Peggy M. Root if additional tents are to be placed on the pavilion grounds.
- ☺ A handicapped accessible picnic table is available in the pavilion.
- ☺ Bathrooms are available only during pool hours. If the pool area closes early, the lifeguard will notify the guests at the pavilion so they may use the facilities before they leave the premises. Pool hours are from noon until 7:00 pm Monday thru Friday and 10:00 am until 7:00 pm Saturdays and Sundays. (*Pool hours are subject to change weather permitting*).
- ☺ Parking is available across the street from the pool and a limited amount of parking on the pool grounds. The creek bed, tree limbs, and other falling objects may cause damage to your vehicle. The Village of Little Valley will not be liable for damage caused while parked on Village property.
- ☺ The Village of Little Valley will not be responsible for lost or stolen property while at the pavilion or the pool.
- ☺ **NO ALCOHOL OR SMOKING ON VILLAGE PROPERTY.**
- ☺ No swimming is allowed without a lifeguard on duty and first aid is only available at the pool office from the lifeguard on duty.
- ☺ The electrical service provided at the pavilion is limited to 3, 20 amp, 120 volt circuits. There are 2 double outlets one each circuit minimum. One large heating tray or cooker per circuit. The circuits are color coded, like colors indicate the same circuit in the box. Additional electrical services are available at the bathhouse. There are 4, 20 amp, 120 volt circuits available. A waterspout is available at the same location.
- ☺ When the pool is open all rules must be followed. Please see a list of rules located on the outside wall of the pool house. **Children under 13 who cannot pass the deep end test may not swim without a parent or guardian present. No infant or child may swim in the kiddie pool without a parent or guardian present and the proper swimming attire. If you have any questions please see the lifeguard on duty.**
